Historical Commission Meeting Minutes

CALL TO ORDER: 7:30 PM

DISCUSSION:

- Request has been submitted to consider the demolition of “The Importer” Barn and house remains on Lancaster Avenue. The commission has requested that the owner, Tom MacCrory, provide an historic impact study on the property. This is Historic Site #07 Benjamin Hibberd Farm.
- Alex DiMattia has requested commission opinion on the installation of solar panels on the property at 1238 W King & Morstein Roads. Upon added discussion with the other members, a recommendation on solar panels attached to the barn/garage will be made. This is Historic Site #101 Fortune Fullerton House
- Mr. Nagel requested a revisit to the offices of chairman and secretary to the Historical Commission. Tim Caban will remain Chairman and Terri Schatz will be Secretary.
- A discussion ensued about the possibility of an award for the best renovation and adaptive reuse of a Historical property in the township. We agreed that the barn and silo at site #10 Adam Reitenbaugh Barn on Swedesford road should be considered. Further opinions on the title of the award will be discussed.
- Terri Schatz will pick up the Gunkle Mill file from EW Township to be delivered to Frens and Frens sometime next week.
- Membership to the Chester County Historical Society for 2017 was confirmed.
