DISCUSSION:

- Mr. Schmidt was at the meeting to ask about work which he planned to do at 3 Frame Avenue (site 201). As the historic building had already had extensive renovation done, he informed us that the new building to be added would conform to the buildings which were next to the one he asked approval on. Extensive discussion was had and eventually the members asked him to return when we could see more detailed plans of what changes he had in mind.
- The Mannix Barn (site 92) which is historical, will not be impacted by the pipeline and members asked to visit the barn.
- Members discussed the clean- up of the Ebenezer AME church property and asked for a review of the letter giving permission to do so. Terri will provide copies of the letter.
- The property at 99 Church Road could receive a township recognition but the historical significance is not known.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Further discussion about historical markers ensued. A draft list of potential markers was passed to members. Terri will make a phone call about a marker from Chester County.
- As time was getting late we had a limited amount of time to discuss the EW book. Terri and Susan took the comments with them to view. Comments about the content and not the style were requested as final editing had not been done.
