1. Call to Order: Ginger Pohlman called the regular meeting to order at 7:35 PM.
2. Approval of the minutes: Ginger Pohlman made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of February 1, 2018 as written. Jon Buzan seconded and the vote was unanimous.
3. Discussions:
  - Jon Buzan reported that Steve Brown has submitted a second draft of the Technical Evaluation Grant application for the Bishop Tube site. Following the suggestions of DEP, additional details were provided regarding cost estimates and scope of tasks to be completed.
  - The field work for the leaking pipe mitigation plan at the Bishop Tube site is now scheduled for April 10, 2018 after being postponed due to snowstorms.
  - A new monitoring well associated with the Malvern TCE site has been installed. Samples taken from this new well indicate that VOCs are present at concentrations similar to those found in the nearest well. Biodegradation products believed to be related to the AISB remedy were also observed in the new well, indicating that it will be useful for monitoring progress of AISB.

5. Old Business: There were no old business items.
6. New Business: There were no new business items.
7. Meeting Adjournment: The meeting adjourned at 9:20 PM.
