1. Call to Order: Ginger Pohlman called the regular meeting to order at 7:35 PM.
2. Approval of the minutes: Ginger Pohlman made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of March 7, 2019 as written. Gary Sheridan seconded and the vote was unanimous.
3. Discussions:
  - Update on the Malvern TCE site by Tim Gallagher: Geosyntec (the contractor for the PRP) proposes installing an additional monitoring well at the end of the Spruce Road cul-de-sac for continued study of the TCE site plume. While it was hoped that GW19 would be a clean northern boundary well, 18 months of monitoring indicates the presence of TCE, DCE, and VC in groundwater. Based on this update, the EAC recommends that the proposed well be installed for the purpose of delineation of the plume.
  - Update on the Bishop Tube site: Five proposals, submitted in response to the RFP for services related to the TEG, were reviewed. Based on discussions with Township officials, the EAC will meet with a selected number of these consulting companies in order to further discuss their proposals.
4. Public Comment: There were no comments made.
5. Old Business: There were no old business items.
6. New Business: There were no new business items.
7. Meeting Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 PM.
