This Philadelphia suburb is the best place to live in America, ranking shows

A Philadelphia suburb was listed as the best place to live in the United States, according to a new ranking from Pittsburgh-based company Niche.

Niche released its annual report of best places to live in the United States based on public school system rankings, cost of living expenses, crime statistics and other datasets. The company researches the country's neighborhoods, school districts, colleges and other sectors.

According to Niche, the best place to live in America, which is also the best place to live in Pennsylvania, is the Philadelphia suburb of Chesterbrook. The community of 4,700 got an overall A+ Niche Grade and received an A+ for its public school system. Another Philadelphia suburb also made the top 10 nationwide: Ranking at No. 5 was Penn Wynne, which also had A+ school and community ratings.

Rounding out the top five places to live in the country, according to Niche, is second-place Bluemont in Arlington, Virginia; third-place Radnor/Fort Myer Heights in Arlington and fourth-place Holly Hills in Denver.

Niche also ranked the best places to live in Pennsylvania based on the same criteria. Chesterbrook and Penn Wynne took the top two spots, while Ardmore took

third-place, Houserville near State College slotted in fourth-place and Swarthmore took fifth-place.

Locally, the following communities made the top 10 in the best places to live in Pennsylvania rankings:

Chesterbrook - No. 1
Penn Wynne - No. 2
Ardmore - No. 3
Swarthmore - No. 5
Berwyn - No. 6
Devon - No. 9
East Whiteland Township - No. 10

Springdale Township in Camden County made New Jersey's top 10 best places to live, landing at No. 7. In Delaware, Pike Creek (No. 1), Delaware Avenue in Wilmington (No. 2), North Star (No. 4), Hockessin (No. 5), Lower Highlands in Wilmington (No. 6), Greenville (No. 7), Little Italy in Wilmington (No. 8) and Bellefonte (No. 9) all made the top 10.
